During this time, she worked to strengthen the HR function in territory, delivering global training and development programmes, introducing a number of well-being initiatives and offering a valuable source of support and guidance to staff members. Before moving to Australia, she worked for BBC Worldwide in the UK where she led a project to configure and implement a new global Performance, Talent and Learning Management System and re-launched the global induction program for new starters.

Naomi joined BBC Worldwide from the Citi Group in October 2009, where she was a Training Consultant.

From 2004 to 2008 she worked for EMI Music, firstly as a Training Analyst and then as a Training and Communications Consultant. She developed and implemented the training strategy for all EMI global systems and devised a communications program to engage all the key stakeholders.
